Little Christmas Trees



These little bead trees are so fast, fun, and easy to make, you will want to decorate everything with them!

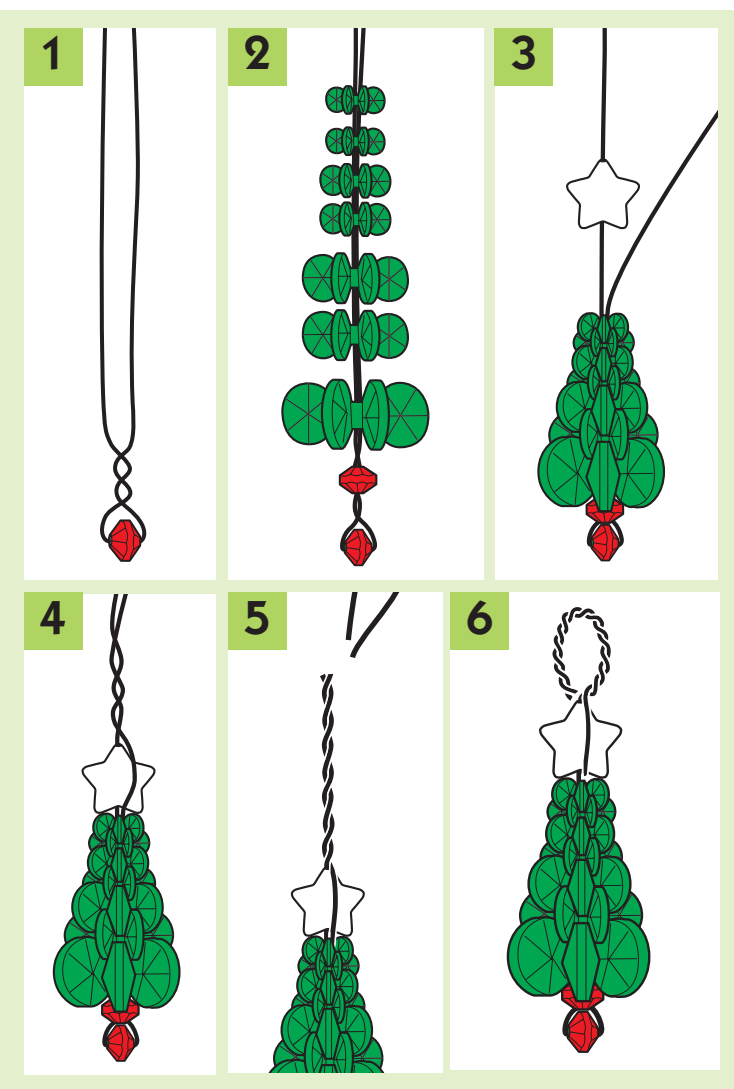
How to make it:

1. Cut a piece of wire 10" (25 cm) long. String on a rondelle bead, center the bead on the wire, and twist wire to hold bead.
2. String these beads on both wires held together:
 - 1 ruby rondelle
 - 1 25mm Sunburst[®] bead
 - 2 18mm Sunburst[®] bead
 - 2 12mm Sunburst[®] bead
 - 2 10mm Sunburst[®] bead
3. Separate the wires, and string a star bead on one wire.
4. Make sure beads are nested together. Twist wires together, beginning at the top of the star and continuing for perhaps an inch (25 mm), or more if a larger loop is desired.
5. Trim off excess wire, and use your pliers to bend the twisted wires into a loop at the top of the star.
6. Use a loop of cord or ribbon to hang the ornament for a Christmas tree decoration, or tie it to a gift package.

What you need for one Little Tree:

- 2 6mm rondelle beads - Ruby
(product code 740V017)
- 1 25mm Sunburst[®] bead – Emerald
(product code 945V007)
- 2 18mm Sunburst[®] beads – Emerald
(product code 950V007)
- 2 12mm Sunburst[®] bead – Emerald
(product code 951V007)
- 2 10mm Sunburst[®] bead – Emerald
(product code 952V007)
- 1 small glass star bead – Crystal AB
(product code 1339H)
- 24 ga. craft wire – imitation gold
(product code 2490S212)

- ribbon or cord to hang ornament
- basic jewelry-making tools:
(wire cutters and long-nose pliers)
OR 3-in-1 tool (product code 1888)
- beading mat (recommended;
product code R81804 or R81805)
OR towel, to lay on the table and prevent beads from rolling around
